Voting Rights Bus Tour arrives in Gainesville to Urge Citizens to #FreeTheVote

Florida Rights Restoration Coalition continues multi-city tour for early voting initiative in support of returning citizens, people with past felony convictions

Fort Lauderdale, FL – On Tuesday, October 27th, the Florida Rights Restoration Coalition (FRRC) continues its statewide voting rights bus tour, stopping in Gainesville. They will partner with local partners and canvassers to mobilize returning citizens, people with past felony convictions, to the polls for early voting.
